FOUCL members gathered at the Union County Public Library on Thursday, October 25, to celebrate National Friends of Libraries Week. Sole Commissioner of Union County, Lamar Paris, issued a proclamation in recognition of the Friends' support of the library, which read in part: "The Friends of Union County Library of Blairsville, Georgia raise money that enables our library to move from good to great - providing the resources for additional programming, much needed equipment, support for children's summer reading, promotion of literacy, and special events throughout the year." and "The Friends understand the critical importance of well-funded libraries and advocate to ensure that our library gets the resources it needs to provide a wide variety of services to all ages including access to print and electronic materials, along with expert assistance in research, readers' advisory, and children's services."

This year FOUCL also provided free public programs at the library on the topics: Care of Books, Genealogy, and Fossils and sponsored, for the first time, a well-received Adult Summer Reading Program.

As part of the Mountain Regional Libraries (Towns County, Fannin County, and Union County) and the Georgia Library PINES (Public Information Network for Electronic Services), Union County Public Library patrons have access to many resources.
