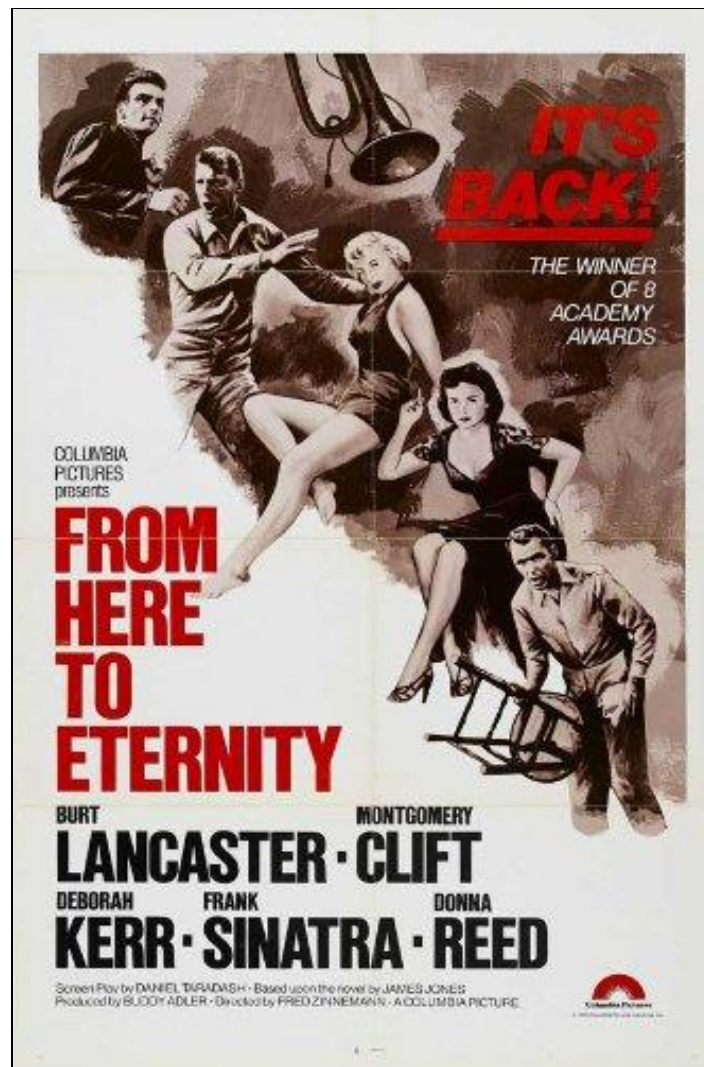

## "The Sting"

Winner of 7 Academy Awards, The Sting is based on the nonfiction book "The Big Con: the Story of the Confidence Man" by David Maurer, a professor of linguists who specialized in con-man slang. Following the murder of a mutual friend, aspiring con-man Johnny Hooker teams up with old pro Henry Gondorff to take revenge, but things don't go according to plan, requiring some last-minute improvisation. Starring:- Robert Redford, Paul Newman, Robert Shaw - filmed in 1973, runs about 129 minutes



## "From Here to Eternity"

Winner of 8 Oscars, and based on James Jones' first novel by the same name, the film is set at an Army barracks in Hawaii in the days preceding the attack on Pearl Harbor, lone-wolf soldier and boxing champion "Prew" refuses to box, preferring to play the bugle. Hard-hearted Capt. Holmes subjects Prew to a grueling series of punishments while, unknown to Holmes, the gruff but fair Sgt. Warden engages in a clandestine affair with the captain's mistreated wife. Starring: Burt Lancaster, Frank Sinatra, Donna Reed - filmed in 1953, runs about 118 minutes
