We will only be able to accept like-new used books for this special sale. Criteria for acceptance include:

- *Newish books that are in great shape, both fiction and nonfiction
- *The most sellable books – those that have been on bestseller's lists or have received awards
- *Classics (for example, *Don Quixote* or *Little Women*) in excellent shape
- *Children's books in great shape
- *Books with no signs of mold, mildew, or water damage.

Any book donations you are able to give FOUCL for this sale will help purchase books, tapes, movies, CDs, DVDs, newspapers, magazines, equipment, and supplies above and beyond what the library budget allows; will help support programs like Summer Reading and Ferst Foundation; and will help sponsor programs at the library like the recent free and open to the public events on Care and Evaluation of Book Collections and Genealogy: Uncover Your Family Roots.
