Peach State Federal Credit Union Helps Expand DVD Collection at Union County Public Library

Thanks to a generous donation from Peach State Federal Credit Union, the Friends of Union County Library (FOUCL) have purchased more than 50 new DVD titles for the Union County Public Library, with a focus on popular boxed series.

This contribution comes at a critical time, as the State of Georgia no longer allocates funds for library DVD purchases. The decision was based on the perception that most residents have access to high-speed internet and can stream content. However, in Union County nearly 20% of residents still lack high-speed internet due to cost or limited availability—making physical media an essential resource for many.

DVDs are the third most circulated item in the Union County Public Library system, behind only books and audiobooks. The newly added titles will help meet ongoing demand, particularly among patrons who rely on the library for home entertainment and educational content.

FOUCL and library staff express gratitude to Peach State Federal Credit Union for helping bridge the digital divide and ensuring that all members of the community have access to quality resources. Friends of Union County Library is a volunteer organization that supports our Union County Public Library with needs outside of their given budget.
